Common Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Walk at all times ● Stand on the ground or designated surfaces ● Enter and exit buildings in an orderly manner ● Move carefully in crowded areas ● Use equipment properly and only when instructed to do so 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Respect property, yours and others ● Place trash & recyclables in proper containers ● Use appropriate language and volume ● Use equipment as directed and return to designated area ● Students who arrive before school starts can utilize Library, Pavilion and back area 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Follow directions of all staff and remind others to do the same ● Inform staff (i.e. Text-A-Tip, Campus Supervisor, etc.) of areas and problems that need attention ● Clean up after yourself ● Remind others to clean up after themselves

Parking Lot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Drive safely and follow traffic laws and speed limits ● Students in grades 11 & 12 can access cars in parking lot at the beginning of break/lunch only ● Obtain proper school parking permit (Student Activities Office) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Respect property; yours and others ● Show your off campus card to staff member/campus supervisor when exiting the parking lot ● Student parking is permitted in the main lot. Staff parking spaces are first two rows of main lot 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Organize your belongings according to break and lunch time access ● Monitor break/lunch time and return to campus after obtaining belonging
