He has never expressed interest in coding again. I would guess that boys constitute the bulk of behavior problems...could these two factors be linked? The other area of failure in the district has been in GATE education. Space here is not enough, but it is clear that from the top levels and trickling down to the classroom level there has been a lack of understanding of GATE education, characteristics and social emotional needs of gifted students.
