Senior Project: 7 Minute Activity

Give an overview of your activity. What did you do for your 20 hours?

What did you know about your topic before? Explain again why you picked this topic.

Explain how you found your mentor

Explain how your mentor helped you.

Explain your 20 hours. Who, what, when, where? Give step by step what you did.

What was your best memory?

What was your biggest challenge?

What is one thing you will always remember about your project?

Looking back at your paper, what did you learn after having done your 20 hours? Did your opinion change?

What did you know before you started? What do you know now?

What personal growth did you make by doing this project? What qualities did you learn (time management, organization, flexibility, etc.)?

How did this project change you? Will you continue this in the future? If you had done anything differently, what would it have been?

What is the most positive thing that you took out of this experience?

What are you doing next year?

What are your goals for the future?

Overall, how did this project have an impact on your life? (or how did you help others?)

Thank the judges for the time. How will you say this? Ask if they have any questions. How will you say this?
